# \*2016 MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS ARE DUE\*

Renew from October 1, 2015 through February 15, 2016 with NO reinstatement fee

If your application is not received and post dated by November 31, 2015, you may not have access to the club on January 1, 2016 as it takes 30+ days for applications to be processed and checks to clear the bank.

Gate access is turned off between January 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nd, 2016 unless renewals were received by November 31, 2015.

Dues for 2016 are \$65.00 Adult/\$105.00 Family. Because of construction limiting availability, the archery/.22 indoor range fee for the one year of 2016 will be reduced to \$10.00.

It has always been a club rule that each renewal must be on a CURRENT year application. As of Open Enrolment on October 1, 2015, <u>all</u> prior year applications will be returned. It takes a minimum of 30 days for checks to clear the bank and renewal of membership to be processed. Incomplete applications, old applications, or incorrect payments will result in the application being returned which can delay the processing.

All <u>Life Members MUST</u> complete and sign a 2016 application to stay active. 2015 or older applications will be returned. If adding spouse, please include the \$25.00 payment. Access to the Indoor Archery/.22 Range requires inclusion of the \$10.00 payment.

<u>New Memberships</u> for 2016 require a sponsor. Sponsors are current members in good standing for one year without lapse after February 15, 2015. All new memberships are reviewed by the Board Of Directors at the monthly Director's meeting. If there is a concern with your sponsorship, you will be contacted by the Membership Officer.

All **New Members** <u>must attend the General Membership Meeting the first Wednesday of the month they are being voted in to receive their credentials. If a New Member does not attend the membership meeting they will not receive their credentials until they do attend a general membership meeting.</u>

Gate Key Fob replacements can be obtained at membership meetings. Cost: \$15.00.

**NRA Memberships** are available through the club web site. Look for an NRA Icon. Click on the icon to go directly to the NRA membership website. MSPA receives credit for NRA Memberships this way.

**Indoor Center Fire Range #2:** If you have qualified for the Indoor Center Fire Range or if you would like to qualify for access, please contact Stan Gregg at 717-691-7930 **before mailing in your 2016 application**. Those who received instructions in 2015 can follow those same instructions for 2016 without calling.

<u>Military Memberships</u>: To avoid delay in processing, call the Membership Officer before submitting a Membership New Application or Renewal.

## 1<sup>ST</sup> VP REPORT/CHIEF RANGE OFFICER

We are getting close to the hunting season and the 50/100 yard ranges will be seeing more use for sighting -in rifles. Please make sure to assign a range officer when there is more than one shooter on the range and sign in when using any of the ranges. The club rule of not stapling your targets to the range frames also includes the 100 yards. Please make sure your targets are set between the frames to avoid damaging them. Stapling/shooting into the frames is a club violation.

Please remember that all range maintenance is being done by volunteers. Please respect their work and time by making sure to pick up your brass and remove your targets when you are done shooting.

Please make sure you <u>only</u> do standing shooting on the 7- and 15-yard ranges. These ranges were designed for standing only and not to be used from a sitting position.

Please respect the Club Security Officers if approached on the ranges. You will not be approached if you are following club rules and are displaying club ID.

The Steel Plate Shoots consist of 50 round fired with a \$10.00 registration fee and are held on Saturday mornings from 9:00 am in the Pit. You must register by 10:30 am at the latest.

The High Power Matches are held in late spring through early fall on one Sunday a month on the 100-yard range with a \$15.00 registration fee.

The fish are growing and getting bigger. This growth is due to our dedicated feeders. The trout get hand fed 3 times a day. Thanks to all the feeders. We will be stocking the pond over the fall and winter when pond temperatures and help allows. No firm dates yet. Keep eye on website for dates. Also if you just want to help stock, contact me with your phone number and I will call when we need help stocking.

We will be holding a Fishing derby at the Fish Nursery on Saturday September 12th. There will be residents from several local nursing homes fishing for some very nice trout. We stock the stream below the fish nursery and have them line up in wheelchairs and chairs. We filet the fish for them to take home and provide a lunch. Look for pictures on website.

We had a flood that killed some of our bigger trout this summer. We lost around 15 fish, a 27 inch, and two 22 inch were the biggest ones lost. We still have some big fish left and hopefully with plenty of food they will get as big as the ones we lost.

#### **4-H SHOOTING SPORTS**

4-H is a community of young people across America who learn leadership, citizenship, and life skills. The focus of all 4-H programs is the development of youth as individuals and as responsible and productive citizens. Mechanicsburg's 4-H Shooting Sports Program stands out as an example. Youth learn marksmanship, the safe and responsible use of firearms, record-keeping and much more. The activities of the program and the support of NRA-Certified adult leaders provide young people with opportunities to develop life skills, self-worth, responsibility, and ethics.

The program offers junior shooters an opportunity to be engaged in positive youth development experiences and recognized for marksmanship performance. Juniors learn to shoot air rifle, air pistol, .22 rifle, shotgun, and muzzle loaders. The Shooting Sports Program develops skills for life and activities for a lifetime.

We just finished the 2014-2015 program with the muzzle loading rifle project. In all, twelve youth were involved in different projects ranging from Air Rifle to .22 Riflery. The 2015-2016 program begins with the first meeting at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, October 6 at the clubhouse across from the trap field. Boys and girls, ages 10-16, are welcome to join. #### **RELOADING CLASS -- RIFLE & PISTOL CARTRIDGES**

For the price of two boxes of ammunition, you can gain the lifetime skill of ammunition reloading. Attend the NRA Basic Reloading Course for Metallic Cartridges held at MSA on Saturday, February 28, 2016 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. A team of NRA Certified Firearms Instructors will provide this 8-hour course which covers the basic knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to safely reload metallic cartridges for your rifle or handgun. The \$50 fee covers the NRA Reloading textbook, NRA Safety Rules pamphlet, use of all reloading equipment and supplies, as well as a full day's training.

Topics include introduction to reloading and reloading safety, using the reloading manual and reloading data, selecting and setting up reloading equipment, requirements for a basic reloading bench, and a hands-on opportunity to practice reloading pistol and rifle cartridges.

An NRA Certificate of Completion will be awarded for successfully completing the course. This is not an advanced reloading course; it is intended for beginning reloaders. Pre-registration is required as class size is limited—for more information or to register for the class, contact Ron Keslar, 717-432-9039, rjkeslar@aol.com.
