Tim Wenrich DCO - Spoke to members about PGC business regarding Semi auto weapons legislation usage introduced; there were 2 Pheasant farms closed (western and north central) AFFECTING 14 Employees, proposed Pheasant permit, and a reduced pheasant production to about 170,000. Pending Bear harvest, 2579 taken during 2016 season, of which 3 were taken in Cumberland County vs 7 last season in 2015. Deer season active this year, local pressure consistent, Archery and Flintlock season until Jan 14th. THE classes at MSA will be held in March, June and September, check PGC web site for dates and information. Hunting License increase not approved as of yet. See PGC web site for Commission business.
