PRESIDENTS REPORT – DENNIS FILLMORE

Dennis announced there would be no December Membership meeting, due to minimal attendance due hunting season. Reported on holes in range roof, and other misuse of ranges. Will be looking into making changes to ranges to improve safety for membership and neighbors. Several trees down from this week's winds were cleaned up, more to go. Reminder about firewood being available. There was an Insurance inspection last week, some minor issues were corrected. PFSC Senate bill to set a term on Pa Fish and Boat Director was presented to the Commissioners. Passed the Senate rapidly. There was reaction to possible Hatchery closings. A House bill to take Wildlife management away from PGC and give to a politically appointed panel, tried before and went nowhere.

SECOND V-PRESIDENT'S - Dennis for Ron Keslar Ron and Dan retired from 4-H program, Linda and John Gingrich will take over the program. A metallic reloading class will be held in Feb 2018.

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY'S REPORT – SHARON GREGG - Sharon reported on Income between 9/20-10/24 as \$10,215.00, and donations through the same time period of \$2,025.000. Renewals as of meeting night was 348. There are 9 applicants for membership w/a total 9 adults and 3 children, 9 were present at meeting. A motion to accept applicants by current members, (23 present) by Sharon, second by Ken Bowen, Vote unanimous by current members to accept. There were 7 adults and 1 child submitted after deadline, they will be processed and contacted when checks clear the bank. A membership committee has been formed to streamline process, and will meet Tuesday's.
